A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FINES FOR USING FIREWORKS AND OPEN WOOD FIRES WITHIN INTERLAKEN TOWN

WHEREAS, the Wasatch County Fire Marshal has prohibited fireworks and wood fires in certain areas of cities where vegetation is overgrown or in benches and foothills where wild land fire potential is extreme;

WHEREAS, all of Interlaken Town is situated in the foothills where wild land fire potential is extreme;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby RESOLVED, that the Town Council of Interlaken, Utah, in order to provide for the safety and welfare of the town, by discouraging the prohibited use of fireworks and open wood fires, establishes a schedule of fines for using fireworks or building open wood fires within Interlaken Town limits:

Schedule of Fines for Using Fireworks and Open Wood Fires:
