



## Fire Restriction Order Effective Immediately (Amended July 3, 2012)

Due to the extremely dry condition and heavy loading of vegetation throughout Bryce Canyon City and surrounding areas, Bryce Canyon City has determined that immediate measures must be taken to prevent fires. The following acts are prohibited on the areas, roads and trails described below until rescinded by Bryce Canyon City:

- Setting, building, maintaining, attending or using open fires of any kind.  
**Gas, electric or charcoal stove fires ONLY will be permitted.**
- Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site or while stopped in an area at least six feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable material down to mineral soil. Cigarette butts must be completely extinguished and disposed of in ash trays.
- Discharging, or using any kind of fireworks, tracer ammunition or other pyrotechnic devices, including sparklers. **No Private Fireworks Allowed.**
- Cutting, welding, or grinding metal in area of dry vegetation.


The following persons are exempted from above prohibitions:


- Those persons with a permit authorizing the otherwise prohibited act at a specific location.
- Any Federal, State, Local Fire Officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Area Description:

- All lands within the boundaries of Bryce Canyon City, Utah  
Effective 11:00 A.M., 3<sup>rd</sup> day of July, 2012.

Violation of the above prohibited acts is punishable as a class B misdemeanor.
