

2020 FIREWORK GUIDELINES

Utah fireworks laws have changed this year, allowing the purchase of legal fireworks from June 24 – July 25, 2020. Fireworks can only be discharged two days prior and one day after the holiday (July 4 and July 24). Fireworks may only be discharged from 11:00 am to 11:00 pm with the hours extended to midnight on the 4th and the 24th.

In addition to the rules above, and due to the extremely dry conditions this year, Bluffdale City is issuing the following firework guidelines within our city limits.

- We recommend no aerial fireworks anywhere within the city limits except at the following locations between 9:00 pm and 11:00 pm:
 - Independence Park located at 15245 S Noell Nelson Drive
 - Bluffdale City Main Park located at 2400 W 14400 S
- Fireworks that do not leave the ground (fountains, candles, flowers, etc.) should be used with caution.

If no other emergency calls come in to pull them away, there will be firefighters at both parks on the 4th and 24th with gifts for the kids and to help with safety.

Fireworks Safety Tips

Use only legal fireworks.

Buy only fireworks that are approved by your state. Avoid buying fireworks that are packaged in brown paper.



Keep water close.

Do not forget to place a bucket of water nearby in case of emergency. Keep in mind to douse burned fireworks with water before throwing to the trash bin.



Keep a distance from the firework.

Once you've lit the fuse, move away immediately. In case the firework did not light properly, douse it with water and do not attempt to relight it.



Use fireworks outdoors.

Remember to use only fireworks outside and away from wooden and other flammable materials. Make sure children are away from fireworks.
