

Fireworks Discharge Restricted Area

Discharge of Class C (State-approved) fireworks are permitted:

- Between 11am and 11pm except as noted:
- July 2-5 (July 4 hours extended to midnight)
- July 22-25 (July 24 hours extended to midnight)
- December 31* (11am to 1am, Jan. 1)
- Chinese New Year's Eve (11am to 1am the following day)

Please note additional restrictions on the map.
**If New Year's Eve is on a Sunday and the county, municipality, or metro township determines to celebrate New Year's Eve on the prior Saturday (Dec. 30), then a person may discharge Class C common state approved explosives on that prior Saturday within the county, municipality, or metro township (Utah Code 53-7-225)*
