Fire Restrictions:

Due to current weather conditions, along with dry vegetation and extreme fire conditions, the following fire restrictions will be enforced immediately in Stockton, Utah.

1. No open fires, of any kind, except in permanently constructed fire pits with a source of pressurized running water. An area of **at least 10 feet** around the fire pit must be clear of vegetation and any other ignition hazards. Fires must be kept small and for personal use in nature and size.
2. No smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle, trailer or building, or other area that is paved or free of dry vegetation.
3. No cutting, welding or grinding metal in areas of dry vegetation.
4. No operation of a motorcycle, ATV, chainsaw, or other small internal combustion engine without an approved and working spark arrestor.

The above restrictions will remain in place until further notice. As we continue to monitor fire conditions, be aware that stricter measures may be adopted as needed.
