Members of the public and the fire service were in attendance at this meeting. The attendance log is kept with the full record of the meeting.

Item #1, Board meeting called to order by Board Chair David Olsen. The meeting started at 8:30 A.M., over Google Meet, and at the State Fire Marshal's Office. Board Member Roll Call – quorum present.

Item #2, Approval of the January 10, 2023 board meeting minutes. Motion made by Frank Park to approve the minutes; seconded by Derek Maxfield. Motion carried.

Item #3, Report to the Board by Chief Scott Spencer, Chair, Utah Fire Service Certification Council.

- Last meeting of the Council was January 5, 2023
- The Council recognized Chief Jason Earl and Chief Rod Hammer for their many years of service to the Council.
- Certification testing continues to increase.
- Joan Aaron reported on her attendance at the Pro Board Winter Conference.
- Have received requests for intent to participate from Box Elder County Sheriff's Search and Rescue and the Utah Motorsports campus.
- There are ongoing discussions on the prerequisites for some of the classes. M410, which is part of the wildland cadre, will be allowed. Have had several discussions on technical rescue and if additional vetting should be required for recertification. The conclusion is that technicians must submit a skill sheet with their recertification that shows they have worked on certain skills in-house.
- The Council approved a Utah standard for live fire training. There will not be IFSAC or Pro-Board seals, it is a Utah standard. This will be discussed in more detail later in this meeting.
- March 20-24 is the tester certification training seminar and will be held at various locations throughout Utah.
- Next meeting is March 15th at 10 am at the Fire Academy.

Item #4, Report to the Board by Jolene Chamberlain on behalf of Bradley Wardle, Utah Fire and Rescue Academy.

- UFRA is doing a great job. Classes continue to be scheduled and are going well. Certifications are also going well.

Item #5, Presentation to the Board by Jolene Chamberlain of the “Utah Live Fire Training Standard.”

- This is standard 1403 which was previously removed from Utah law.
- There is now a new 1403 standard which was approved by the Certification Council at the last meeting. It is to support Utah in live fire and how to do things on a State level. It is more “user-friendly” for those who choose to use it.
- Recognition of committee members who worked diligently on this standard: Deputy Chief Jason Beck, Lone Peak; Chief T.J. Brewer, Moab; Chief Brett Pierson, Kanab; Chief Mike Phillips, Cedar City; Chief Scott Spencer, Payson; Deputy Chief Bart Vawdrey, Draper City; Battalion Chief Dave Youngberg, North Davis; and Joan Aaron, UFRA.

Item #9, The Board expresses its thanks to Chief Jason Earl and Chief Rod Hammer for their year of service on the Utah Fire Service Certification Council.

- Chair David Olson expressed thanks for the hard work and many years of service each has given. They have been very involved in the process. Jolene Chamberlain added that Chief Earl served for 14 years, and Chief Hammer for 10 years. Both have spent countless hours on committees and working for the Certification Council.

Item #10, Legislative status of the 2021 International Fire Code, Ted Black, Utah State Fire Marshal.

- House Bill 409 passed, which is the adoption of the 2021 International Fire Code with the normal changes made for the State of Utah. The fuel gas code did not pass. An advance copy of the fuel gas code was reviewed and the LP Gas Board recommended approval to the State Legislature. For some reason, NFPA has decided not to adopt a 2023 edition, but to go to a 2024 edition of the code. The language in the law is specific to 2023, so it had to be dropped as a 2023 edition of the fuel gas code does not exist.
- There were some changes in Miranda rights for juveniles. Made easier for children to understand. There was also a provision in another bill that requires a parent or friendly adult to be in the room with the child when interviewed.
- Minimum road widths on minor roads in residential subdivisions will be 32' of asphalt or pavement, plus curb and gutter.

Item #11, Schedule an appeal hearing for Mr. Steve Shriber/Firestorm. Mr. Shriber is appealing the decision of the State Fire Marshal, Ted Black, to not renew his Display Operator and Special Effects Operator licenses. The requested date by the Fire Marshal is May 09, 2023.

- Chief Phillips recommended a separate meeting from the usual Fire Prevention Board Meeting.
- Joe Decker also recommended a separate meeting.
- April 11, 2023, was proposed for this special meeting. Board members were encouraged to attend in person.
- Motion was made by Joe Decker to hold a special meeting for the appeal hearing of Mr. Steve Shriber on April 11, 2023, at 8:30 am, with the option to attend in person or virtually. Motion seconded by Chief Mike Phillips.
